### ORIENTATION for VOLUNTEERS for Camille Griffin Graham Women's Prison

Have you ever been interested in volunteering at the women's prison or attending one of All Saints' Eucharists held there twice a year?

Has it been three years since your last prison orientation? (That includes most of the current All Saints' volunteers).

Then you need to attend Chaplain James Major's orientation for volunteers on Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at 3pm at Trinity Cathedral.

Pastor Patricia and several other area priests are starting a weekly "Blessing and Healing Circle" at the prison which will include Bible Study and a healing Eucharist. The five priests will rotate through the weeks. Lay members of our churches are welcome to come with us any week to participate and assist, but you must have completed the prison orientation and forms to be able to do so. We hope to begin the program in May, 2016, so the April 6<sup>th</sup> orientation date above is being offered.

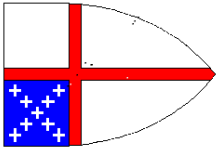
