

Thank you to all in the parish that have supported the flower/candle ministry this past year. I am in the process of reconciling the 2019 flower and candle account. If you have forgotten to reconcile your flower and candle dedication, please do so as soon as possible. The new 2020 calendar is located next to the parish office. This self-supporting ministry is a lovely way to make dedications in memory or honor of loved ones or events or to give glory to God.

We continue the Christian year following Advent and Christmas with Epiphany on January 6th. We will celebrate on Sunday, January 5th with the children presenting an Epiphany piece during the 10:30 service. February 2, 2020 is The Presentation of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Temple. During the 10:30 service we will recognize and give thanks for all the memorials and gifts given to the church. Ash Wednesday, Feb 26th begins our Lenten season; a time of reflection and repentance. Then, following the events of his earthly life of self-sacrifice, we celebrate His Death, Resurrection, and Ascension, (Holy Week and Easter) and the gift of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. The second half of the Church Year (season of Pentecost) celebrates the continuing work of Christ, in His Church, through the Spirit.

The Christian Year is as old as the Resurrection of our Lord and as new as the latest revisions. The Episcopal Church, Anglican Church, Roman Catholic Church, Greek Orthodox Church and other Protestant denominations follow this liturgical Christian Year. This Christian "calendar" year is followed at All Saints' Church, noted visually by the changing colors of the hangings in the sanctuary.
